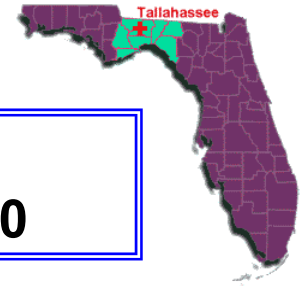


# Capital Area Chapter American Red Cross Situation Report # 4 – 6/13/06 – 6:00PM

### Damage Assessment (Information Management Support Services – Disaster Assessment)

#### Impact Assessment:

- On-line Damage Assessment web site ([www.tallytown.com/redcross/DamageAssessment.html](http://www.tallytown.com/redcross/DamageAssessment.html)) has been activated
- Damage Assessment Teams have returned from Taylor, Wakulla and Franklin Counties coastal areas. No residential damage was identified.

The following preliminary information is received from the county EOCs:

- Leon - No reported damage.
- Franklin County - Mandatory evacuation of Alligator Point lifted. Some minor damage to east end of Alligator Point Road, still passable. Minor flooding on low lying roads, reported passable. No reports of damage to structures
- Wakulla County - No reported damage to roads or structures.
- Taylor County - A few downed trees, sporadic minor power outages. All roads passable, no structures reported damaged. Expect storm to pass by 12:00PM today.
- Dixie County - Some minor water on roads, 26 homes without power expected to be restored shortly, no structural damage
- Jefferson County – No reported damage to roads or structures.
