CURRENT SITUATION

Tropical Storm Alberto Makes Landfall...

Reports from an air force reserve unit hurricane hunter aircraft and National Weather Service Doppler Radar observations indicate that the **center** of Tropical Storm Alberto has made landfall in the Big Bend area of Florida near Adams Beach about 50 miles southeast of Tallahassee Florida around 1230 pm.



State Actions

- The State Emergency Operations Center is at Level 1 Activation
- Conference calls with counties conducted daily at 1115 and 1715 Hours
- SEOC briefings are held twice daily
- The Florida Emergency Information Line has been activated (1-800-342-3557)
