### Florida American Red Cross Chapter Activities

#### Capital Area Chapter

(Counties Served: Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Taylor and Wakulla)

The chapter's Disaster Services Management Team has been placed on STAND-BY.

All of the chapter's Disaster Services Volunteers have been notified and instructed to monitor the chapter's Disaster Services Volunteer Information Hotline for additional instruction should the chapter activate its Emergency Operations Center.

#### Central Panhandle Chapter

(Counties Served: Bay, Calhoun, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson and Washington)

The chapter's Disaster Services Leadership Team has been placed on STAND-BY.

#### North Central Florida Chapter

(Counties Served: Alachua, Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Lafayette, Levy, and Suwannee)

The chapter's Disaster Services Leadership, Disaster Service Committee, Disaster Action Teams and Disaster Services Volunteers have been placed on STAND-BY.

Shelters have been identified by County Emergency Management and American Red Cross should an evacuation be implemented.

#### Northwest Florida Chapter

(Counties Served: Escambia, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa and Walton)

A Disaster Services Volunteer call down is being conducted in anticipation of opening an unknown number of shelters.

Local feeding vendors have been placed on STAND-BY.

American Red Cross liaison staff has been identified to deploy should counties open their Emergency Operations Centers.
