Florida American Red Cross Chapter Activities

Capital Area Chapter

(Counties Served: Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Taylor and Wakulla)

No new activity to report.

Central Panhandle Chapter

(Counties Served: Bay, Calhoun, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson and Washington)

None of the county EOCs are currently open.

North Central Florida Chapter

(Counties Served: Alachua, Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Lafayette, Levy, and Suwannee)

No new activity to report.

Northwest Florida Chapter

(Counties Served: Escambia, Okaloosa, Santa Rosa and Walton)

All county EOCs are activated and staffed with ARC liaison.

Seven (7) shelters are open with five (5) additional shelters on STAND-BY.

Due to the anticipated flooding conditions and storm surge, Escambia County is calling for the following evacuations as of 3:00PM today:

Anyone living in the Category 1 Evacuation Area should begin evacuations. This includes Perdido Key, Pensacola Beach, Inerarity Point and all areas south of Gulf Beach Highway.

Anyone living in a mobile / manufactured home, travel trailer / RV or FEMA group site should also evacuate.

Additionally anyone living on the waterways in Escambia County should plan to evacuate
