

**Tropical Storm Barry

Situation Report 10 August 16 2001**

Current Conditions

The flood water has receded to a point in the Munson Slough area of Leon County that all families that were isolated now have access to their homes.

Mass Care (Sheltering and Feeding)

A Mobile Shower Unit continues operations at the Service Center located at:

Woodville Baptist Church
9500 Woodville Highway
Woodville Florida

The level of activity at the Mobile Shower Unit has dropped to only five (5) to eight (8) people per day. The Mobile Shower Unit will cease operations at 8:00PM Friday August 17.

Two (2) Mobile Feeding units are operational in the Munson Slough area of Leon County. A 48 hour notice was posted with the evening meal last night that all feeding will end with the Friday August 17 evening meal.

One (1) Emergency Aid Station remains operational daily between the hours of 9:00AM and 7:00PM at the corner of Oak Ridge Road and State Road 61. The following services are available snacks, drinks, meals, bottled water, comfort kits and disaster preparedness / mitigation information. Notice has been posted that this Emergency Aid Station will cease operations at 12:00PM on Saturday August 18.

This Emergency Aid Station is currently staffed only by the Mass Care function.

Comfort Kits provided to-date: 362
Clean-Up Kits provided to-date: 3

Family Services

Family Services Outreach Teams have swept through all the known damaged areas.

As of this report a total of 49 Emergency Assistance cases have been opened during this Disaster Relief Operation.

Staffing
