Mass Care – Feeding (Community Services – Feeding)

- Meals for 15,000 persons have been delivered to Second Harvest to go with the Kitchen when deployed.
- Snacks/Meals ordered/distributed to Chiles High School for 6:00PM Friday shelter opening. This shelter closed at 10:15PM due to no clients. This shelter was reopened at 12:00PM on Saturday.
- ERV 1074 stationed at I-10 East Bound Rest Area in eastern Leon County to provide Mass Care support and distribute hurricane shelter information.
- 361 meals served and 580 snacks served for this period.

Logistics (Material Support Services & Technology)

- Four trucks have been rented. Plans to transport the Mobile Kitchen have been made with Parkway Wrecker.
- Completed a facilities agreement for Raa Middle School as a site for Disaster Relief Operations Headquarters.
- Shelter trailers located at all open shelters
- LIRV and E-Serv arriving Sunday from National for staging to West Florida

Communications (Material Support Services & Technology)

- Radio operators are assigned to the Chapter's EOC communications.

Family Services (Individual Client Services – Client Casework)

- No new information to report.

Disaster Health Services (Individual Client Services – Health Services)

- Nurses are on-call for open shelters.

Disaster Mental Health Services (Individual Client Services – Mental Health Services)

- Mental Health workers are either located or on-call for all shelters.

Disaster Welfare Inquiry (Individual Client Services – Welfare Information)

- No new information to report.

Government Liaison (Partnership Services – Government)

- No new information to report.

Volunteer Agency Liaison (Partnership Services)

- Big Bend Disaster Animal Response Team: Representative in the Chapter's EOC. Pet friendly shelter has been co-located with the Lawton Chiles High School shelter for emergency situations.

Staffing (Staff Services – Workforce Planning & Acquisition)

- 131 volunteers have registered for assignment.
