Logistics

Disaster Health Services

A nurse has been placed on-call/or located at the open shelters. DHS is working on a staffing plan for the next 3-4 days.

Disaster Mental Health Services

A mental health worker has been placed on-call at the open shelters. DMHS is working on a staffing plan for the next 3-4 days.

Partner Organizations

All partner organizations are being contacted. 211 Big Bend, Big Bend DART and the FSU Center for Civic Education have established a presence in the EOC. Volunteers are reporting in from other partner organizations such as the Suwannee River Area Council of the Boy Scout of America. Girl Scouts of the Apalachee Bend, Rotary Club District 6940, and Tallahassee Amateur Radio Society.
