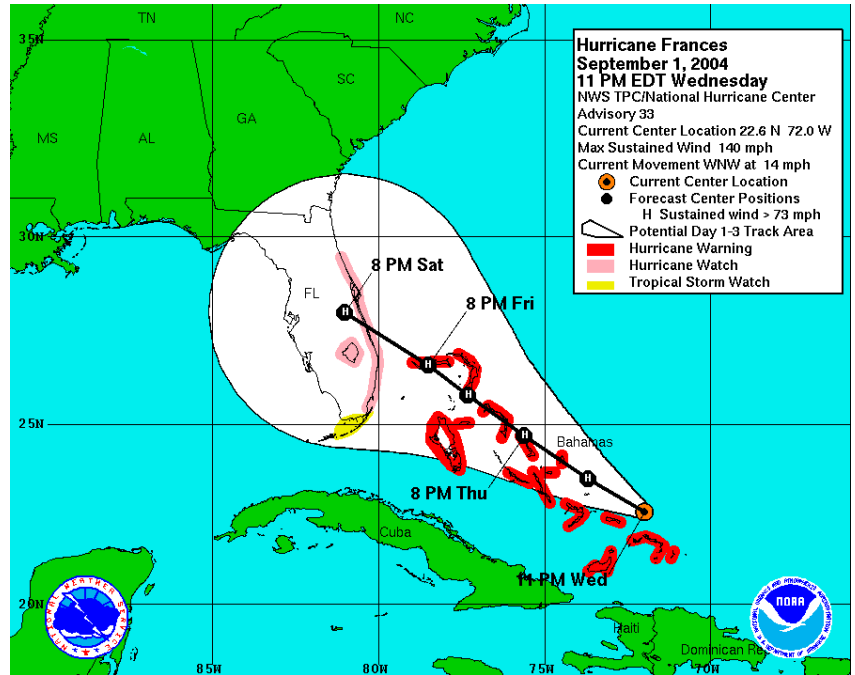

CURRENT SITUATION

NATIONAL HURRICANE CENTER ISSUES HURRICANE AND TROPICAL STORM WATCHES FOR PORTIONS OF FLORIDA...

At 2300 hours, the National Hurricane Center issued a Hurricane Watch for the Florida east coast from Florida City, northward to Flagler Beach (including Lake Okeechobee). Some or all of the Hurricane Watch area will likely be upgraded to a Hurricane warning Thursday morning. A Hurricane Watch means that hurricane conditions are possible within 36 hours.

A Tropical Storm Watch has been issued for the middle and upper Florida Keys from south of Florida City, southward to the Seven Mile Bridge (including Florida Bay).



STATE ACTIONS

The SEOC is currently at a Level 1 Activation and continues to plan and prepare for Hurricane Frances.
