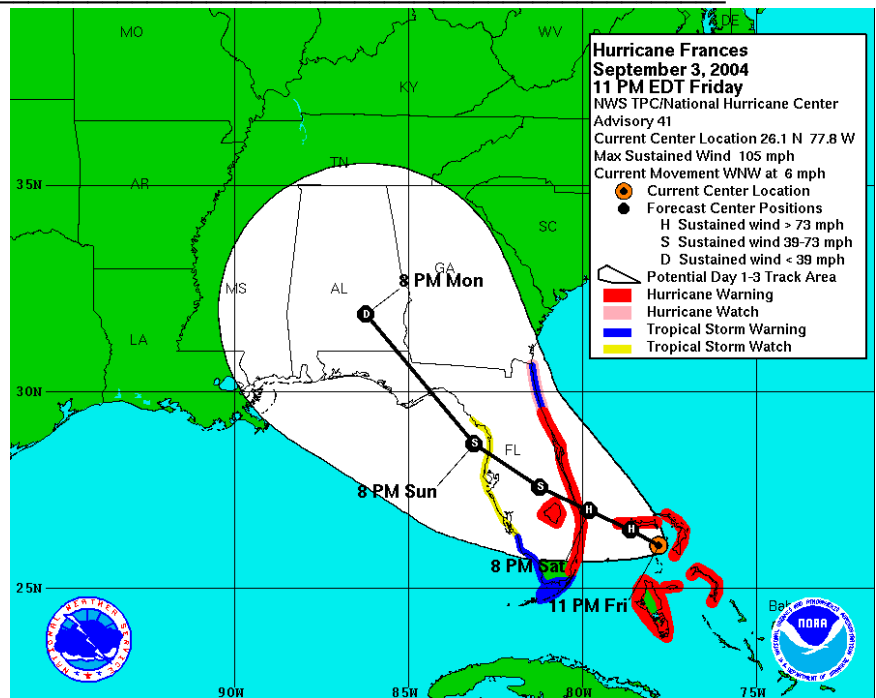
Tropical Storm Watch and Warning Issued

CURRENT SITUATION

National Hurricane Center Issues a Tropical Storm Warning and Watch for Portions of Southwest Florida... At 1100 p.m., EDT, the National Hurricane Center issued a **Tropical Storm Warning** for the southwest coast of Florida from Bonita Beach eastward to south of Florida City and a **Tropical Storm Watch** for the Florida west coast from north of Bonita Beach to the Suwannee River (See Forecast Map).

In addition to the above **watch and warning**, a **Hurricane Warning** remains in effect for the east coast of Florida from Florida City, northward to Flagler Beach (including Lake Okeechobee). Also, the **Hurricane Watch** and **Tropical Storm Warning** remain in effect from north of Flagler Beach to Fernandina Beach.



STATE ACTIONS

The SEOC remains at a Level 1 Activation and continues to plan and prepare for Hurricane Frances.
