Mass Care - Feeding

Mass Care Feeding is moving perishable food supplies from Second Harvest Food Bank to the Civic Center. Four Emergency Response Vehicles and 8 trucks are loaded awaiting further deployment. 50,000 meals and 40,000 cases of water are being distributed to shelters that are to be opened and being staged for further deployment.
