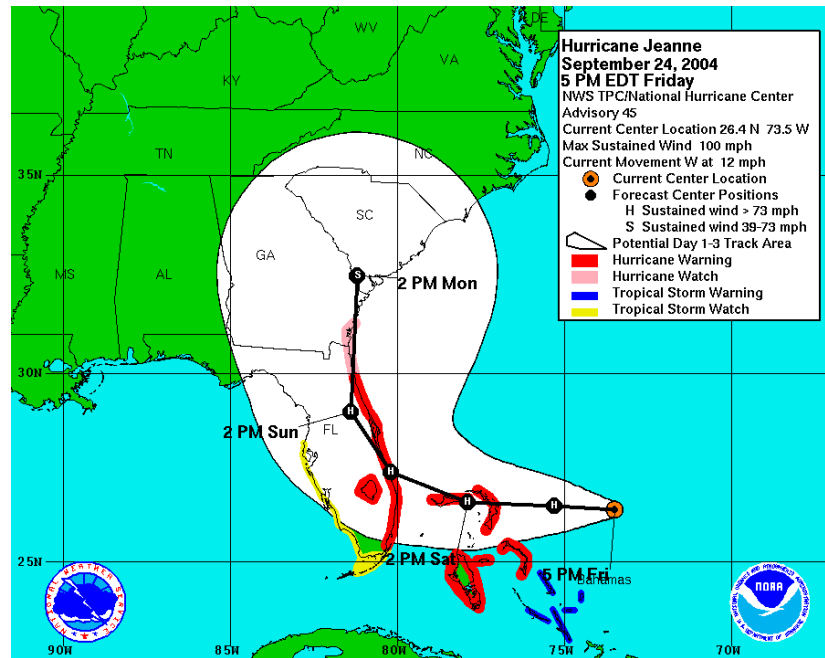
CURRENT SITUATION

HURRICANE WARNINGS ISSUED FOR FLORIDA EAST COAST...

At 1700 hrs, EDT, the National Hurricane Center upgraded the Hurricane Watch to a Hurricane Warning along the Florida east coast from Florida City, northward to St. Augustine, including Lake Okeechobee. A hurricane warning means that hurricane conditions are expected in the warning area within the next 24 hours (See Forecast Map).

STATE ACTIONS

The SEOC is currently at a Level 1 Activation in response to Hurricanes Charley, Frances, and Ivan. The State Emergency Response Team continues to monitor the progress of Hurricane Jeanne.
