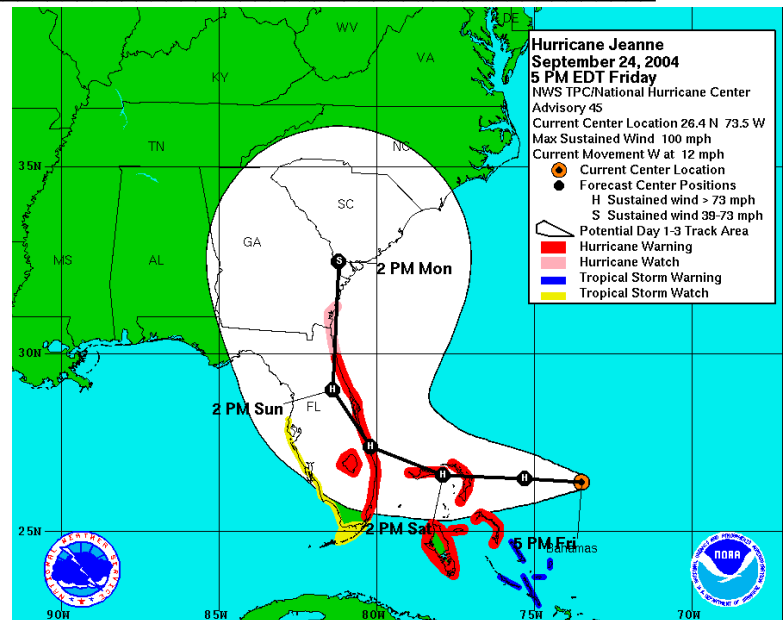
Turkey Point and St. Lucie Declare Unusual Event (Hurricane Jeanne)

CURRENT SITUATION

FLORIDA NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS DECLARE UNUSUAL EVENTS...

The St. Lucie Nuclear Power Plant in St. Lucie County and the Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant in Miami-Dade County have issued "Unusual Event" Emergency notifications in response to Hurricane Jeanne's anticipated approach to the Florida east coast. **No recommended actions have been issued at this time.** At 5 pm EDT, the center of Hurricane Jeanne was located near Latitude 26.4 north and Longitude 73.5 west. This is also about 400 miles east of the southeast Florida coast. Jeanne is moving toward the west near 12 mph and this general motion is expected to continue for the next 24 hours (See Forecast Map).



STATE ACTIONS

The SEOC is currently at Level 1 Activation in response to Hurricanes Charley, Frances, and Ivan. The State Emergency Response Team continues to monitor the progress of Hurricane Jeanne.
