Preliminary Damage Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Wildfire in Columbia County currently slowed down and has reached to within about 3 miles East of U S Highway 441 and 7 miles North of Interstate 10.○ The Florida Highway Patrol has closed Interstate 10 from Sanderson in Baker County to Live Oak in Suwannee County.○ Interstate 75 has been closed from U S Highway 90 in Lake City to the Georgia Stateline.○ Traffic has been routed VIA U S Highway 90.○ As of this report only one (1) non-residential structure has been lost and no residential structures have been affected.
